Apply for a Free \$90 voucher!

New Throne for Your Home Toilet Voucher Program

Get rid of your old toilet and save a king's ransom in money and water!

If your home was built prior to 1992 and you have an existing high-flow toilet or toilets, you may be eligible for a voucher worth up to **\$90** for one toilet or **\$180** for two toilets.

Older toilet models purchased before 1992 use between 3 to 7 gallons per flush (gpf). Low-flow toilets use less than 1.6 gpf and high-efficiency (dual-flush) toilets use less than 1.3 gpf. In addition to the value of the voucher (\$90), it is possible for a family of three to save over 30 gallons of water per day or 10,600 gallons annually. This saves you money on both water and wastewater charges.

To Qualify:

- Must be a Dallas Water Utilities customer.
- Toilets must be installed in a residence built before 1992.
- There is a limit of two (2) toilets per residence.
- Each new toilet must replace an existing large-capacity toilet (7, 5, or 3.5 gpf).
- Old toilets cannot be reused. Customer agrees to disable their old toilets.
- Customer must agree to an installation verification visit by City of Dallas staff.
- Customer agrees to complete a brief post-installation telephone survey.
- Customer has not received a low-flow toilet from other City of Dallas programs.

Please Note:

- Customer is responsible for installation and any costs above \$90.
- **Only participating retailers will accept the voucher.** Customers will receive a list of participating locations and approved toilets when they receive their voucher. *A voucher must be presented to the retailer in order to receive credit towards your purchase.*
- This program is a multi-year program; however, the number of vouchers issued each year are subject to budget appropriations and are issued on a first-come, first-served basis.
